TOWN PERMISSION

Town Permission establishes blanket consent for your son or daughter to take un-chaperoned, off campus leaves that do not involve an overnight stay. These leaves can occur on weekdays after school, Saturdays and Sundays. Town permissions involve visits for shopping, dining, movies or similar excursions. Student transportation for town is governed by their Automobile Riding Permission as established by parents, excluding freshmen. Leave times and curfews and procedures are outlined in the *Student/Parent Handbook*. Parents and students are required to be familiar with *the Handbook* guidelines and students found in violation face disciplinary consequences.
