

ST. BERNARD PREPARATORY SCHOOL

Uniform Code, 2010-2011

The St. Bernard Preparatory School Dress Code represents St. Bernard's history, tradition and community, The code also represents one's choice and commitment to attend St. Bernard and to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the School.

UNIFORM – BOYS:

1. **BLAZER:** Navy blue blazer (brass buttons) specified by the school. Put your name in the blazer.
2. **SHIRTS:** Plain white button-down collar oxford cloth standard cut dress shirts with white buttons; no logos, decorations or color trimming that is visible. Shirts must be pressed, wrinkle free, all buttons applied, no holes, and must be worn tucked inside. (Recommend at least five). Only a white, non-printed T-shirt may be worn underneath.
3. **TIE:** Two current school ties. Ties must be clean, appropriately tied, no holes, etc.
4. **PANTS:** Khaki pants specified by the school. Pants must fit properly (especially waist and length). Must be worn with a belt. No holes or frayed pant legs.
5. **BELT:** Plain, single-color solid black or brown belts.
6. **SOCKS:** Single color solid black, brown, navy blue or white socks must be worn while in uniform.
7. **SHOES:** Solid black or dark brown single-color polished smooth leather with dark brown or black soles. No open toes or heels, no cloth, suede or athletic shoes, no clogs, moccasins, or sandals.
8. **Optional:** Uniform polo golf-type shirts (white: with monogrammed SBP logo) may be worn on days designated by the administration. Must be wrinkle-free and tucked into the pants.
9. **Optional:** Navy blue sweater vest specified by the school.
10. **Optional:** SBP Letterman jacket may be worn on any approved day.

UNIFORM – GIRLS:

1. **BLAZER:** Burgundy in color (brass buttons) as specified by the school. Returning girls who have purchased navy blue blazers may continue to wear those blazers until summer 2012. Put name in blazer.
2. **BLOUSE:** Plain white button-down collar oxford cloth standard cut blouses with white buttons; no logos, decorations or color trimming that is visible. Blouses must fit properly, be tucked in and neatly pressed and clean. Only a white, non-printed T-shirt may be worn under blouse. Undergarments under blouse must be white or in the wearer's flesh-tone. All shirts must be worn tucked into the skirt or pants, all buttons applied and no holes.
3. **SKIRTS** specified by the school. Length must fall to mid-knee or no higher than 2 inches above the knee.
4. **PANTS:** Khaki pants specified by the school. Pants must fit properly (especially waist and length). Must be worn with a belt. No holes or frayed pant legs.
5. **BELT:** Plain, single-color solid black or brown belts.
6. **SOCKS:** Burgundy, no higher than the knee. Natural color or burgundy hosiery or tights.
7. **SHOES:** Solid black or dark brown single-color polished smooth leather with dark brown or black soles. No open toes or heels, no cloth, suede or athletic shoes, no clogs, moccasins, or sandals.
8. **Optional:** Uniform polo golf-type shirts (navy blue: with monogrammed logo) may be worn on days designated by the administration. Must fit properly and be tucked into the skirt or pants.
9. **Optional:** Burgundy uniform sweater or sweater vest. Sweater may not be worn tied around the hips or hanging below the jacket.
10. **Optional:** Letterman jacket may be worn on any approved day.
11. **Optional:** girls may choose to wear the School tie; if so, see 4.2 c above. May use only with skirt.
